

SPECIAL EVENT TEXAS DISTRICT RALLY FRIDAY EVENING, MAY 15, 2009



Welcome to the “Grand Canyon of Texas”

Located about 30 minutes south of Amarillo lies the stunning grandeur of Palo Duro Canyon, a 60 mile - long and 800-foot-deep canyon carved out of the Texas High Plains. Visitors to 16,402-acre Palo Duro Canyon State Park are treated to towering cliffs layered with bands of red, yellow, purple and white. Patches of juniper, mesquite, sunflower and prickly pear cacti adorn the canyon slopes, while red clay and veins of white gypsum blanket the ground.

Sixteen miles of scenic drives wind through the canyon, crossing the Prairie Dog Town Fork of the Red River at six locations. The Red River, although small in appearance is responsible for forming the impressive canyon.
