Today, this is known as The Old Jody's Restaurant. Jody and Mary's son, Joey Franks, took over the restaurant in 1984. Jody and Mary retired in 1995. Joey and his wife, Sheryl Franks, take pride in the lessons and values they were taught by Jody and Mary. Another generation of grandchildren are currently "growing up" in the restaurant and learning the value of family tradition.

Family owned and operated for over 65 years, Old Jody's has built its reputation on fresh-made daily southern favorites, the friendliest staff and a environment like no other.
