Classroom activities start at 8:00 A.M. each day and continue until 4:30 P.M. on Saturday and about 3:30 P.M. on Sunday. Note: Education Weekend's complete schedule is posted on the District website and also attached to this month's newsletter.

Education weekend can be attended by any active GWRRA member and/or friend of an active GWRRA member, with registration information posted on the District website, including the necessary forms.

Pre-registration is mandatory for all courses involving a cost, plus the SPDP (Seminar Presenters Development Program), thus ensuring the proper supplies are available at class time.

Texas District is offering two very special events at Education Weekend, which includes Region H's Rider Education Directors holding a Seminar Presenters Development Program (SPDP), for GWRRA members interested in becoming Seminar Presenters.

The second special event is Region H's Director, Harry Dollarhide, a Master Instructor, has offered to conduct an Instructor Course Program to certify Trailering Instructors. This will require some pre-course assignments, which can be secured from National's RE website, under RC Certification.

The Texas District also needs qualified RiderCoach Instructors for the Trike Course, Trailing Course, ARC, Road Captain Course, Crash Scene Response, Motorcycling for Mature Riders, and Trailing Seminar. We are also in need of persons to assist in the Trike Course, Trailing Course, and ARC, setting cones, etc. These persons do not need to be certified RC Instructors.

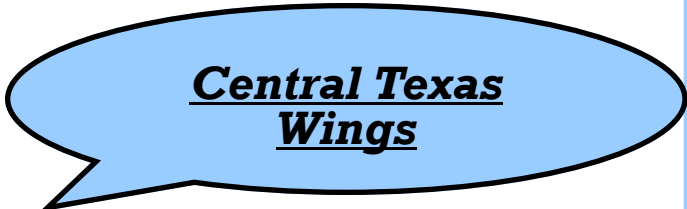

T-FEST Information



Chapter "T" was officially chartered in October of 1998 with Mike and Donna H. as the first Chapter Directors. The Chapter Kick-off Rally was in November 1998 at Dana Peak Park on a very cold, rainy, Saturday. It was so nasty that the treasurer, Mel C. didn't attempt to count the money until she got home and dried out and warmed up. Everyone felt bad thinking that we didn't make enough money to even cover expenses. That first "T" Fest, as it has become known, grossed approximately \$1200.00. Weather conditions were so bad at one point, a couple of members went home and got some kerosene heaters and tarps to help ward off the cold. After a couple of "T" Fests Mike and Donna stepped down and Jesse and Gina M. took over as Directors. When Mike and Donna stepped down there were 72 full time members. Jesse and Gina were directors for a couple of years and Chapter "T" grew to 102 members. These membership numbers reflect "Charter Members", "Regular GWRRA Members" and "Associate Members" and their families. The chapter had gotten so big that we won the largest chapter/club at the Tri-County Toy Run in December 1999.

According to GWRRA anyone who joins a new chapter during the first 90 days is eligible to be a Charter Member, Chapter "T" had 46 Charter Members.

In our twelve years Chapter "T" has participated in, and raised money for, many different charitable organizations in the area, including the Killeen Food Care Center, The Fisher House on Ft Hood, Habitat for Humanity, Peaceable Kingdom, and several other individual charities. We have also participated in numerous other community events and are active in many civic organizations.

[On October 2, 2010 we are hosting our Annual "T-FEST" Motorcycle Convention\(Rally.\)](#)

This year it will be held at the Armed Forces E9 Association building at 699 E. Veterans Memorial Boulevard in Harker Heights. Our event is publicized state-wide, so we expect attendees from near and far. This year we are supporting the Coats for Children Campaign.

We have had several Chapter Directors including, Mike and Donna H. (founders and first directors), Jesse and Gina M., Keith and Suzanne V. (only for a couple of months) Vickie and Paul H., "Jimbo" and Tammy L., and Steve and Betty P., Dale & Carleen G. and currently Jim & Alvalin W. Yes, we even had a Lady Director, Vickie H. was listed as the Chapter Director and was the first and only female Director up to this point. The great thing about Chapter "T" is that most of the chapter directors are still to this date active members of GWRRA and Chapter "T".

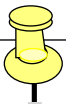

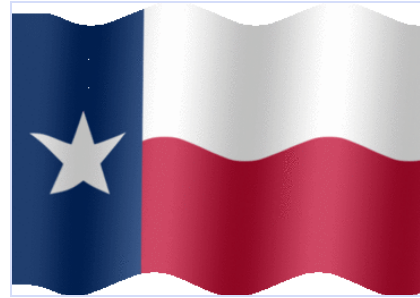
